

# WINES BY THE GLASS

## SOMMELIER INSIGNIA SELECTIONS

6oz / 3oz

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**Overture by Opus One, “Bordeaux Blend”, Napa Valley M.V. . . . . . \$45 / \$23**  
The nose shows sweet vanilla, black cherry and cassis wrapped around a core of tobacco.

**Emmolo by Caymus, Merlot, Rutherford, Napa Valley 2013. . . . . \$20 / \$10**  
This first release exhibits aromas of mahogany smoke, leather and brown spice, while earthy flavors intertwine with caramelized plum and smooth tannins reminiscent of ground cocoa.

**Caymus, Cabernet Sauvignon, Rutherford, Napa Valley 2014 . . . . . \$40 / \$20**  
A beautiful ripe, plump, fat and opulent style of Cabernet Sauvignon that Caymus has pioneered, the 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon has a dense purple color, loads of juicy blackberry and blackcurrant fruit, low acidity and no real evidence of oak, but a nice, plush, full-bodied opulence.

**Abstract by Orin Swift, Syrah, Petit Syrah, & Grenache, Napa Valley 2014. . . . \$20 / \$10**  
A vivid nose of red and black stone fruits, candied cherry, cassis, dried floral notes, and sweet oak accents. Fleshy and spirited, the wine evolves into a very complex flavor profile of dark berry preserve, raspberry jam, Asian spices, mocha, chaparral, and a hint of crushed rock minerality.

**Cherry Pie, Stanley Ranch Vineyard, Carneros, Napa Valley 2013. . . . . \$22 / \$11**  
At shows tons of textural richness in its ripe red fruit aromas. Big, rich flavors dominate this wine. There is no shortage of lush, overt fruit this year.

**Jordan, Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, Sonoma 2012. . . . . \$25 / \$13**  
Aromas of blackberry, blueberry and cassis mingle with hints of violet and dark chocolate to seduce and intrigue. The palate is inviting and silky, with a vivid core of cassis that defines every sip, balanced by a backbone of acidity and a smooth tannin structure.

**Dancing Hares, “Mad Hatter”, Cabernet Sauvignon Based Blend, . . . . . \$24 / \$12**  
**Napa Valley 2011**  
This is a complex, with rich, loamy earth, currant, dried berry and hints of sage, gaining body and traction throughout the mid palate and ending with a complex, mouthcoating, flavorful finish.

**Stags Leap Winery, “Artemis”, Napa Valley 2014. . . . . \$30 / \$15**  
With an intense ruby-red color, the wine has profound aromas of red and black fruits. On the palate, the wine’s dense structure is balanced and elegant, with a silky presence.

## SPARKLING WINES & SAKE

**Champagne, Nicolas Feuillatte, “Brut”, France MV (187ml) . . . . . \$18**  
Floral aromas of fruit with notes of white fruits: pear, apple, almonds and hazelnuts.

**Champagne Rosé, Moët & Chandon, “Brut Rose Imperial”, France NV (187ml) . . . . . \$20**  
This Champagne displays lively, expressive, aromas dominated by the scent of wild strawberries. It is full-bodied, with zestful, assertive fruitiness.

**Prosecco, Ballata, Veneto, Italy MV (187ml) . . . . . \$12**  
Fine and fruity on the nose, full-flavoured yet delicate, fresh and appealing.

**Hinomaru Jōzō, Manabito Kimoto Junmai Ginjō, Akita Prefecture, Japan . . . . . \$12**  
Combining the earthiness of the traditional Kimoto brewing method with the delicacy of Junmai Ginjo, this sake is mellow with nice acidity.

**Rihaku, “Dreamy Clouds”, Nigori Tokubetsu Junmai, Shimane Prefecture, Japan . . . \$12**  
A complex aroma profile touching on steamed rice, cream, slight toffee and a hint of plum skin.

## WHITES & ROSÉ

### LIGHT, DRY & CRISP

**Pinot Grigio, Lagaria, Delle Venezia, Italy 2016 . . . . . \$12**  
Straw yellow in color, pleasant floral and fruity aromas of apple, apricot and pear. Medium-bodied, with refreshing fruit, distinct character and balance.

**Albariño, Torres, “Pazo Das Bruxas”, Rias Baixas, Spain 2016 . . . . . \$12**  
Nose offers perfumed and citrus notes coupled with white peach over a touch of minerality characteristic of the terroir. Sweet upon entry, followed by a fresh, clean evolution across the palate and a long, elegant finish.

**Moscato d’Asti, Luca Bosio, Piedmont, Italy 2016 . . . . . \$12**  
Intense aromas of peaches, rose petals, and ginger. On the palate it is delicately sweet and sparkling with modest acidity, good balance, good complexity, and a finish of fresh apricots.

**Rosé, Pierpaolo Pecorari, Ros’alba, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy 2016 . . . . . \$12**  
Aromas and flavors of red cherry, ruby red grapefruit, and cranberry; hints of violet, lavender, and pink peppercorn.

**Sauvignon Blanc, Nobilo, Marlborough, New Zealand 2015 . . . . . \$12**  
Starts with aromas of citrus fruit, jalapeno, and tropical fruit. Crisp & clean on the palate with pure fruit flavors combined with juicy acidity.

### MEDIUM BODIED, MORE AROMATIC

**Chardonnay, Milestone, California 2014 . . . . . \$12**  
Refreshingly crisp, displaying sweet aromas, a fresh, fruit-forward style, and subtle notes of vanilla.

**Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita, Alto Adige, Italy 2015. . . . . \$17**  
Intense aroma and bone-dry taste with an appealing flavor of Golden Delicious apples.

**Riesling, Red Hook, “Seneca Lake”, Finger Lakes, New York 2016. . . . . \$12**  
Bright bouquet of minerality, guava, honeysuckle, floral and ripe stone fruit. The palate features ripe stone fruit and tropical flavors; good texture and length in the finish with concentrated notes of mineral, citrus and lime.

**Riesling, Havemeyer, “Piesporter Goldtropfchen Spätlese”, . . . . . \$14**  
**Mosel, Germany 2015**  
A tart and sweet wine that offers notes of lime, green apple and candied pear.

**Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine Pastou, Sancerre, Loire Valley, France 2016 . . . . . \$14**  
Fresh and inviting aromas of citrus fruits laced with floral and mineral notes.

### RICH & MORE FULL BODIED

**Chardonnay, Niner, Edna Valley, California 2013 . . . . . \$15**  
Starts with light buttered notes and toasted marshmallow with notes of fresh peach and green apple. Citrus laced mid palate with a creamy texture.

## RED

### LIGHTER & FRUITIER

**Pinot Noir, Acrobat by King Estate, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2014 . . . . . \$14**  
Bright fruit aromas of cherry cola, cranberry, earth leather that give way to vanilla and plum.

**Pinot Noir, Sartori, Veneto, Italy 2014 . . . . . \$12**  
An alluring bouquet of black-cherry jam, black pepper, cloves, and chocolate. On the palate, the wine is elegantly well-balanced with a fine balance of acidity and a persistent finish.

### ROUNDER, SOFTER & MORE MEDIUM BODIED

**Cabernet Sauvignon, Ironstone, Lodi, California 2015. . . . . \$12**  
Dark cherry and toasted oak aromas lead into juicy black currant, raspberry and dark cherry flavors. This luscious, well-balanced wine has a sweet middle palate that finishes with a toasty oak component.

**Chianti Classico, Lamole di Lamole, Tuscany, Italy 2013. . . . . \$14**  
Deep ruby color, opening on black cherry and forest fruit fragrances that mingle with floral aromatics and very sweet spiciness. The initial depth, roundness and mouthfeel take you into a full, pulpy mid palate and finish again dominated by fruit and spice sweetness.

**Malbec, Portillo, Valle de Uco Mendoza, Argentina 2014. . . . . \$12**  
Rich with fruit, the nose is reminiscent of plums and blackberries. Fresh flavors of red currant and black cherry supported by sweet, round tannins ending in a long finish with notes of cinnamon and cloves.

**Merlot, Redhook, “Volpe”, North Fork of Long Island, New York 2013 . . . . . \$13**  
Aromatics of blackberry, plum, and light chocolate. Savory hints show in the background. The bright palate is lined with a stony thread lending spine and definition. Very fine tannins along with bright dark cherry and minerality on the generous finish.

**Tempranillo, Bodegas Muriel, Reserva, Rioja, Spain 2011 . . . . . \$12**  
High aromatic intensity, with a variety of fresh berries, blueberries, currants, raspberries. Balance and harmony among all taste components. There is a structured wine, with softness and freshness on the end.

### FULL BODIED, MORE TANNIN, LONGER FINISH

**Barolo, Attilio Ghisolfi, “Bussia”, Piemonte, Italy 2010 . . . . . \$20**  
Underbrush, black raspberry, dark cherry, sage, spice, espresso, chocolate and balsamic notes are some of the sensations that emerge from this structured Barolo.

**Cabernet Sauvignon, Felino, Vina Cobos, Mendoza, Argentina 2015. . . . . \$13**  
A nose delivering powerful, plush cherry and cedar flavors. Waves of bold, plush black cherry and mint flavors on the palate.

**Cabernet Sauvignon, Round Pond, “Kith & Kin”, Rutherford Napa Valley, . . . . . \$17**  
**California 2014**  
Aromas of candied cherries, cassis and strawberries with vanilla cream. The supple entry opens brightly with intense sweet fresh fruit of blackberry and boysenberry. Softening through the mid-palate, ashy red fruits of black cherry and rhubarb add a layer of complexity to this classic Napa Valley Cabernet. Notes of toasted nuts and tobacco follow.

**Cabernet Sauvignon, Emblem by Michael Mondavi, Napa Valley, California 2013 . . . \$22**  
Aromas of ripe blackberries and dark cherries woven together with sweet spices and a dusting of cocoa powder. On the palate this is medium-bodied and beautifully textured with excellent overall balance. Gorgeous fresh ripe dark fruits continue to resonate on the long, persistent finish.

**Cabernet Sauvignon Based Blend, Marietta, “Armé Lot”, Sonoma County, . . . . . \$15**  
**California NV**  
Arme has chewy, rich, concentrated flavors of classic black currant, cherries, smoke and earth, with fine tannins and a long structured finish. The nose elegantly combines aromas of spice-box, green olive and black licorice.

**Petit Syrah Blend, Michael David, “Petite Petit”, Lodi, California 2015. . . . . \$12**  
The wine has layers of fine tannin bolsters the rich blackberry and blueberry flavors, while flashy, spicy, smoky, new-oak accents infuse everything from the aroma to the finish.

**Super Tuscan, I Giusti & Zanza, “Nemorino”, Tuscany, Italy 2008. . . . . \$14**  
It exhibits violet and red berry aromatics. The wine has a very fruit forward red cherry and raspberry, balanced with bright acidity expressing itself on the palate tannins & generous fruit.

**Syrah, Qupé, Santa Barbara County, California 2012 . . . . . \$15**  
Deep and spicy, blue & black fruits, lavender, herbs and black pepper. This is a full bodied Syrah but still savory, elegant with a persistent finish.
