

WINES BY THE GLASS

SOMMELIER INSIGNIA SELECTIONS

6oz / 3oz

Overture by Opus One, “Bordeaux Blend”, Napa Valley M.V. \$55 / \$28
The nose shows sweet vanilla, black cherry and cassis wrapped around a core of tobacco.

Faust, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 2017 \$30 / \$15
Full Throttled cabernet sauvignon, aged for 19 months in 100% French oak it offers nuance and silky tannins and notes of juicy blackberry, black cherry and plum.

Silver Oak, Alexander Valley, Napa 2016 \$45 / \$23
This Cabernet offers alluring notes of chocolate covered strawberries, vanilla, nutmeg and truffle. On the palate delicate entry of cranberry, raspberry and pluot with savory black olives on the mid-palate. The wine finishes with silky tannins, cedar and bramble flavors with excellent length and return.

Caymus, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, 2018 \$50 / \$25
Dark scarlet red color with powerful aromas of sweet rip cabernet grapes. Initial impressions are fantastically appealing, textural sensation of finely grained cacao tannins. The whole wine is balance, rich, expressive and impressively complex, the backbone of fine tannin and sweet ripeness is a carry-over from perfectly mature fruit.

Cherry Pie, Stanley Ranch Vineyard, Carneros, Napa Valley 2016. \$25 / \$13
The wine shows tons of textural richness in its ripe red fruit aromas. Big, rich flavors dominate this wine. There is no shortage of lush, overt fruit this year.

The Prisoner, Red Blend, Oakville, Napa Valley 2018 \$30 / \$15
Aromas of Bing cherry, dark chocolate, clove and roasted fig. Persistent flavors of ripe Raspberry, boysenberry, pomegrate and vanilla linger harmoniously for a smooth and luscious finish.

Nickle and Nickle, Merlot, Bear Flat, Napa Valley 2016 \$28 / \$14
Beautiful balance of rich fruit and supple structure, sage, cedar and plum aromas open onto a palate layered with juicy berry fruit, flavors of spice, black olive and forest floor while a warm oak and silky tannins provide an elegant support into a long lingering finish.

Groth, Oakville, Napa Valley 2016 \$35 / \$18
With an intense ruby-red color, the wine has profound aromas of red and black fruits. On the palate, the wine’s dense structure is balanced and elegant, with a silky presence.

SPARKLING WINES & SAKE

Champagne, Laurent-Perrier, “Brut”, France MV (187ml) \$22
Citrus colored, this signature LP has a refined, fresh and elegant nose with brioche and delicate citrus flavors. Lean, refined and elegant on the palate.

Champagne Rosé, Moët & Chandon, “Brut Rose Imperial”, France NV (187ml) \$22
This Champagne displays lively, expressive, aromas dominated by the scent of wild strawberries. It is full-bodied, with zesty, assertive fruitiness.

Prosecco, Bisol Jeio DOC, Veneto, Italy MV (187ml) \$13
Bright straw yellow with fine bubbles, The bouquet is fragrant and bursting with fruit notes clean and delicate on the palate.

Asahi Shuzo, Dassai 50, Jumai Daiginjo, Yamaguchi Prefecture, Japan. \$12
This sake is light and lovely with a muted fragrance. Its balanced, clean and easy to drink. There are delightful fruits on the palate without coming off too sweet.

Tomoju, “Seven Friends”, Jumai Nigori, Ibaraki, Japan. \$12
This Nigori sake is a real gem; it has a floral aroma and a white cloudy appearance. Its slightly sweet with a smooth finish.

WHITES & ROSÉ

LIGHT, DRY & CRISP

Pinot Grigio, Lagaria, Delle Venezia, Italy 2018. \$12
Straw yellow in color, pleasant floral and fruity aromas of apple, apricot and pear. Medium-bodied, with refreshing fruit, distinct character and balance.

Moscato d’Asti, Luca Bosio, Piedmont, Italy 2019 \$12
Intense aromas of peaches, rose petals, and ginger. On the palate it is delicately sweet and sparkling with modest acidity, good balance, good complexity, and a finish of fresh apricots.

Rose, Chateau Gassier, Cotes de Provence, France 2019 \$14
A very clear rose with shades of peache. Intense nose with delicate aromas of white flowers and white fruit. The mouth is round with notes of citrus fruits and a slight and healthy final acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc, St. Supery, Napa Valley 2018. \$12
Starts with aromas of grapefruit and lime. Crisp and clean on the palate with pure fruit flavors combined with a nice juicy acidity.

MEDIUM BODIED, MORE AROMATIC

Terrazas De Las Andes, Chardonnay, Argentina 2018 \$12
Vibrant and balance, offer aromas of stony mineral, pear and honeysuckle. The palate is clean, and mineral driven with tones of pear and white nectarine. The finish is long with firm mineral tension.

Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita, Alto Adige, Italy 2019. \$18
Intense aroma and bone-dry taste with an appealing flavor of Golden Delicious apples.

Riesling, Red Hook, “Seneca Lake”, Finger Lakes, New York 2017. \$12
Bright bouquet of minerality, guava, honeysuckle, floral and ripe stone fruit. The palate features ripe stone fruit and tropical flavors; good texture and length in the finish with concentrated notes of mineral, citrus and lime.

Nik Weis, Riesling, St Urban-Hof, Mosel, Germany 2018 \$14
Vibrant acidity zingy grapefruit and yellow-cherry flavors collide in this off dry Riesling. Its delightfully forward and fruity yet maintains a nuanced undertone of gun flint and crushed minerals.

Sauvignon Blanc, Domain Cherrier et Fils, Sancerre, Cher, France 2019 \$16
Light yellow notes with hints of flowers and citrus, in the mouth the wine is fresh and round. Good balance with a long harmonious finish and a flinty minerality.

RICH & MORE FULL BODIED

Jordan, Chardonnay, Russian River, Sonoma County 2017 \$19
Crisp refined white is a celebration of lemon zest green apple and wet stone, integrated in oak and bright acidity. Further flavors of pear and white peach.

RED

LIGHTER & FRUITIER

Pinot Noir, Sokol-Blosser, “Evolution”, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2018 \$14
A decadent pinot noir that shows cherries, almonds and raspberries. Medium to full body, delicious tannins and a fresh and juicy finish.

Pinot Noir, Sartori, Veneto, Italy 2017 \$12
An alluring bouquet of black-cherry jam, black pepper, cloves, and chocolate. On the palate, the wine is elegantly well-balanced with a fine balance of acidity and a persistent finish.

ROUNDER, SOFTER & MORE MEDIUM BODIED

Cabernet Sauvignon, Ironstone, Lodi, California 2018 \$12
Dark cherry and toasted oak aromas lead into juicy black currant, raspberry and dark cherry flavors. This luscious, well-balanced wine has a sweet middle palate that finishes with a toasty oak component.

Chianti Classico, Peppoli, Antinori, Tuscany, Italy 2016. \$15
This wine offers intense fruity aromas of violets as well as notes of red black fruit. Evolved aging aromas provide notes of black pepper and tobacco on the palate. This wine delivers both structure and balance with flavors of blackberry and currant enhanced by rich velvety tannins.

Malbec, Portillo, Valle de Uco Mendoza, Argentina 2019 \$12
Rich with fruit, the nose is reminiscent of plums and blackberries. Fresh flavors of red currant and black cherry supported by sweet, round tannins ending in a long finish with notes of cinnamon and cloves.

Merlot, Raphael, North Fork of Long Island, New York 2017. \$13
Aromatics of plum and light chocolate. Savory hints show in the background. The bright palate is lined with a stony thread lending spine and definition. Very fine tannins along with bright dark cherry and minerality on the finish.

Malbec, Pascual Toso, Reserva, Mendoza, Argentina 2016 \$15
This state-grown Malbec reveals a fruity nose filled with plum and quince aromas and a touch of elegant oak The mouth feel is full, with flavors of blackberry and licorice, there are smoky accents of vanilla and lingering oak.

FULL BODIED, MORE TANNIN, LONGER FINISH

Barolo, Albe, G.D. Vajra, Piemonte, Italy 2016. \$20
Bright ruby color, red fruit and plum flavors, flowers, pine needles and a finish that reminds of bushes. Albe is the harmony of sophisticated and delicate perfumes, supported by an elegant acidity and ripe tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Routestock, Napa Valley 2017 \$16
Rich and rather sweet with lots of blackplum character and some toasty oak. This full bodied red is easy to enjoy because it has a rather silky texture and doesn’t finish as heavy.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Round Pond, “Kith & Kin”, Rutherford Napa Valley, \$18
California 2017
Aromas of candied cherries, cassis and strawberries with vanilla cream. The supple entry opens brightly with intense sweet fresh fruit of blackberry and boysenberry. Softening through the mid-palate, ashy red fruits of black cherry and rhubarb add a layer of complexity to this classic Napa Valley Cabernet. Notes of toasted nuts and tobacco follow.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Emblem by Michael Mondavi, Napa Valley, California 2016 . . . \$22
Aromas of ripe blackberries and dark cherries woven together with sweet spices and a dusting of cocoa powder. On the palate this is medium-bodied and beautifully textured with excellent overall balance. Gorgeous fresh ripe dark fruits continue to resonate on the long, persistent finish.

Petit Syrah Blend, Michael David, “Petite Petit”, Lodi, California 2017 \$12
The wine has layers of fine tannin bolsters the rich blackberry and blueberry flavors, while flashy, spicy, smoky, new-oak accents infuse everything from the aroma to the finish.

Super Tuscan, Modus, Ruffino, Tuscany, Italy 2017 \$15
Equal blend of sangiovese cabernet sauvignon and merlot. In the glass it pours rich and purple. It immediately emits aromas of cherries, plums and blueberries. On the palet it has medium tannins that are well integrated with lots of balsamic and sweet tobacco notes.

Zinfandel Based Blend, Klinker Brink, “Brikmason”, Lodi, California 2016 \$14
Dark fruit aromas coupled with exotic spice, tobacco and chocolate, yield to rich fruit flavors on the palate with medium body and a firm structure.
